

3rd Press release

On the 4th of October 2022, most of the partners of the Erasmus+ project ACT4WOMEN travelled to Riga, to attend the 3rd Transnational Partner Meeting of the project which was following the previously adopted hybrid form of conduct. The physical attendees to the meeting were: Rosa Amaro from CIVIC as a project coordinator, Iveta Cirule from Project Net as a host of the meeting, Gergana Deeninichina and Ralitsa Popova from Inspire Bulgaria, Marta Formato and Valentina Ballant from ANI and Paulo Silva from CMP. Online the meeting was attended by Demetra Orthodoxou from Emphasys, Lina Batista and Alexandra Teixeira from CMP, Ersi Niaoti from IDEC.

The partners were happy to meet after the last official TPM in Paris and to follow up with the progress of the project's achievements. The collaboration between the partnering organizations was enhanced due to the opportunity of physical (and hybrid) form of conduct.

During the meeting the partners discussed the current state of the project in terms of development of its results, the dissemination and the visibility, the management aspects and the translation of the content. The coordinator Rosa Amaro presented the updated Gantt chart of the project due to changes in the timing of the activities. The First Intellectual Output was discussed and considered finalized besides the Data Bank which the partners agreed will be under continues development by adding new entries. All training materials of the Second Intellectual Output are developed by the partners and are under peer review process and quality monitoring.

The AR game, part of Intellectual Output 2 was discussed, a draft of it will be prepared by the end of October 2022 by CIVIC. The game will consist of an infographic that includes the 7 points that represent the steps to turn women's ideas into a business. The infographic will contain a QR code that will lead the users to a part of the platform that will contains the 7 steps again, each one with a real-life scenario, a short theory content and an assessment. Each partner will develop content for one of the seven steps and format it in a template provided by Emphasys.

Emphasys also reported that they are working on the digital platform (Intellectual Output Three) and showed a draft to the partners. They still need the final
